



Scott 6th Grade Center Spring Concert Performance Attire

Girls

- Black or spring pastel floor or knee length dress (shoulders should be covered)

- Black or spring shoes

optional – sweater to cover shoulders

- OR -

- Black or pastel shirt or blouse

- Black dress pants/khaki material/floor or knee length dress

- Black shoes

****Note – With knee length skirts or dresses, please take caution with the way you sit when you play your instrument. Also be cautioned with heel height on risers/steps.****

Boys

- Black or pastel button-down long or short sleeve shirt

- Black or color dress pants or khaki material

- Black/dress socks

- Black/dress shoes

- Belt (plain)

optional – Black sports jacket, black or pastel tie

****Yes, students may wear all black uniform from school as their attire.****

Jewelry

- Necklaces should be limited to single strand pearls or “simple” chains with a modest adornment.
- Earrings should be simple, small, modest, and limited to the earlobe. Additional ear piercing should have a clear insert.
- All other piercings should have a clear insert.
- Rings on fingers should not be excessive and you should be mindful of the instrument you play.
- Hair adornments should be limited to simple designs and colored in black.
- Any bracelets or wrist cuffs should be silent and non-distracting.
- Belts should be plain and black. No studded belts will be permitted.
- Hands and arms should be free of extra gloves or bands.

If there are any questions about your chosen attire, please bring it to school for the approval of your teacher prior to the concert date.

Please note that dress-code requirements are not meant to stifle individuality but to model professional behavior and attitude.
