

Scott 6th Grade Center Winter Concert Performance Attire

Girls

- Black floor or knee length dress (shoulders should be covered)
- Black stockings
- Black shoes
- optional* – black sweater to cover shoulders

- OR -

- Black shirt or blouse
- Black dress pants/khaki material/floor or knee length dress
- Black stockings/socks
- Black shoes

****Note – With knee length skirts or dresses, please take caution with the way you sit when you play an instrument, sit in the audience or stand on the choral risers (think modest). Also be cautioned with heel height on risers.****

****Yes, students may wear an all black school uniform as their attire.****

Jewelry

- Necklaces should be limited to single strand pearls or “simple” chains with a modest adornment.
- Earrings should be simple, small and modest.
- All other piercings should be simple, small, and modest or have a clear insert.
- Rings on fingers should not be excessive and you should be mindful if you play an instrument with which a ring might interfere.
- Hair adornments should be limited to simple designs and colored in black.
- Any bracelets or wrist cuffs should be silent and non-distracting.
- Belts should be plain and black. No studded belts will be permitted.
- Hands and arms should be free of extra gloves or bands.
- Hats are not permitted unless otherwise given permission by the music director.

If there are any questions about your chosen attire, please bring it to school for the approval of your teacher prior to the concert date.

Please note that dress-code requirements are not meant to stifle individuality but to model professional behavior and attitude during these musical performances.
